Minimum Veterinary Testing Requirements for Entry

Due to the mission of SVF Foundation we are very concerned about excluding diseases transmitted from parent to offspring-be they inherited or infectious. We expect your veterinarian to conduct a more thorough exam than is required for a health certificate. Our staff will consult with your veterinarian about these details.

Following are the minimum veterinary testing requirements for inclusion in SVF's program:

CATTLE

Disease	Test
Brucellosis	Serology (BRUC CARD)
TB	Tuberculin
Bovine Leucosis Virus (BLV)	Serology (AGID)
Johnes	Serology (ELISA)
Bovine Viral Diarrhea (BVD)	Serology (BVD ACE)
Bluetongue (if from endemic area)	Serology (ELISA)
Anaplasmosis (if from endemic area)	Serology (C-ELISA)
Breeding Soundness Exam (BSE)	Visual and palpation when possible
Footrot, pinkeye, lice, mange	Visual
Vaccines – ensure Rabies, 9-way (Bovishield or equivalent) and blackleg are current	
Interstate Health Certificate signed by accredited veterinarian (SVF will obtain import permit # for RI)	

GOATS

Disease	Test
Caprine Arthritis and Encephalitis (CAE)	Serology (ELISA)
TB	Tuberculin
Brucellosis	Serology (BRUC CARD)
Johnes Disease	Serology (AGID)
Caseous Lymphadenitis (if historical in herd)	Blood test (SHI test at UC Davis lab)
Bluetongue (if from endemic area)	Serology (ELISA)
Internal Parasites	Fecal flotation
Breeding Soundness Examination (BSE)	Visual and palpation when possible
Sore mouth, pinkeye, mange, lice, foot problems	Visual
Vaccines – ensure Rabies and CDT are current	
Interstate Health Certificate signed by accredited veterinarian (SVF will obtain import permit # for RI)

SHEEP

Disease	Test
Caseous Lymphadenitis (if historical in flock)	Blood test (SHI at UC Davis)
Johnes Disease	Serology (AGID or ELISA)
Brucella ovis	Serology (ELISA)
Ovine Progressive Pneumonia (OPP)	Serology (AGID)
Bluetongue	Serology (ELISA)
Internal Parasites	Fecal flotation
Breeding Soundness Exam (BSE)	Visual and palpation (of males) when possible
Psoroptic mange, foot rot, pinkeye, sore mouth, lice	Visual
Vaccines – ensure Rabies and CDT are current	
Interstate Health Certificate signed by accredited veterinarian (SVF will obtain import permit # for RI)	

In some cases alternate tests that are more sensitive than those listed above may be acceptable. Examples of such tests are virus isolation and PCR for the infectious agent in question
